WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as pandemic and where as the Govt, of Odisha in exercise of power conferred under section 2, 3 & 4 of the Epidemic Disease Act. 1897 have promulgated Odisha COVID-19, Regulation-2020 for containment of COVID-19;

AND WHEREAS, the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Govt, of India in exercise of power conferred under section 6(2(i) of the Disaster Management Act. 2005 have directed the State Govt. / State authority to take measures for ensuring social distancing so as to prevent this spread out COVID- 19 & directed the National Executive Committee under the said Act to issue necessary guidelines in this regard;

AND WHEREAS, Govt, of Odisha have issued orders to contain the spread out the COVID-19 vide Order No. 4582/R&DM(DM) dtd.31.07.2020;

AND WHEREAS, the District Magistrate & Collectors have been designated as the Empowered officers u/s 2(1) of Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 & authorized to enforce and implement various measures for containment of the spread of COVID-19.

AND WHEREAS, This, month of August is very critical, for spreading of COVID-19

AND WHEREAS, more than 40 positive cases have been detected in Bhuban NAC area and out of which more cases are local positive cases. It is also apprehended that persons come from adjacent highly vulnerable district to Bhuban NAC may be a carrier & transmit COVID-19 to other healthy people, due to their active exposure. Hence to contain the local transmission of COVID-19 & keeping in view of rising cases of COVID-19 in Bhuban NAC, it is quite essential to take stricter precautionary measures by the District Administration, Dhenkanal.

Now therefore, in exercise of power conferred under Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Epidemic Disease Act. 1897& Regulation-2020, **I Sri Bhumesh Chandra Behera, OAS (SAG), Collector & District Magistrate, Dhenkanal do hereby order to shutdown Bhuban NAC area from 05.08.2020 to 07.08.2020 in order to contain the spread of COVID-19 & to take all preventive and Response Measures.**

Contact Tracing & Surveillance:

There shall be intensive contact tracing in Bhuban NAC. Contacts of the confirmed and suspected cases will be line listed, tracked and kept under surveillance at home for 14 days.

The CDM&PHO, Dhenkanal/ Block Medical Officer I/C, Bhuban, will mobilize required health staff immediately to conduct Active Surveillance in Bhuban NAC. Supervisory Officers will be also named by the CDM&PHO, Dhenkanal. The Active surveillance will start from **05.08.2020** and completed by **07.08.2020**.

The CDM&PHO, Dhenkanal/ Block Medical Officer I/C, Bhuban, shall provide required numbers of masks, hand gloves, head covers to all surveillance team members & supervisors for conducting Active Surveillance in Bhuban NAC and train them accordingly. The aforesaid process must be followed as per the guidelines of H&FW, Deptt. Govt. of Odisha & same must be ensured by CDM&PHO, Dhenkanal. All ILI and SARI cases either reported in the last 14 days by the IDSP or ascertained in course of Active Surveillance exercise will be tracked and reviewed thoroughly. Swab will be collected from all cases of confirmed contact history/Symptoms at the earliest for testing at the designated Labs. *The CDM&PHO, Dhenkanal, shall submit day wise status reports to the undersigned. The assigned responsibilities for smooth implementation of Shutdown as follows,*

1. Marketing Inspector, Bhuban Block- Supply of Essential Commodities.
2. Station Fire Officer, Bhuban - Maintenance of sanitation and sanitization.
3. Tahasildar-Cum-Incident Commander, Bhuban - Maintenance of Law & Order, enforcement and implementation of all activities relating to Containment.
4. Executive Officer, NAC, Bhuban- Over all co-ordination
5. CDM&PHO Dhenkanal/Block Medical Officer I/C, Bhuban - Health/Medical arrangements.
6. Sub-Divisional Police Officer, Kamakhyanagar/IIC, Bhuban PS, shall make necessary arrangement for immediate deployment of adequate police at the points of requirement and to be supervised accordingly.
7. Block Medical Officer I/C, Bhuban / EO, NAC, Bhuban - Active House to House Active Survey & Surveillance.
8. Overall Supervision & Monitoring - Sub-Collector, Kamakhyanagar.

During the shutdown, only these following activities shall be allowed

- a. All medical establishments i.e. hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, including medicine stores, movement of ambulances and all medical personnel
- b. District and municipal administration/police/fire services.
- c. Central & State government officials on emergency duty
- d. Telecom Services.
- e. Petrol Pumps.
- f. Print and Electronic Media identified by the DI & PRO/ District Police.
- g. Water supply, sanitation & sewerage workers
- h. Electricity supply & Distribution
- i. Movement of Goods & good carriers either loaded or unloaded.
- j. Industrial establishment, Factories and Construction activities
- k. All Agriculture, Horticulture & fisheries, animal husbandry, veterinary services & allied activities, including procurement at mandis.
- l. Movement of road transport on highways , road movement of transiting vehicles
- m. Movement of Public Transport, private vehicle and taxis (including cabs by aggregator like Ola, Uber, etc) to and from airport, railway station and bus terminals/stands/stops, for facilitating movement of passengers by air, rail and road.
- n. Marriages and Funeral with permission of the local authority.
- o. ATMs.
- p. Operation of bus station and their associated offices, movement of associated personal and activities'
- q. Home delivery of food, groceries, vegetables and essential items by restaurants and aggregator.
- r. Dhabas along National and State Highways/ Major roads for takeaway only.
- s. Milk booths.
- t. Newspaper hawkers between 5 am and 8 am only
- u. LPG distribution, home delivery of cooking Gases & associated activities, personnel and Vehicular movements.
- v. Banks, Insurance & Financial Institutions including service organizations to operate with not more than 25% of their manpower for essential banking transaction & ATM feeding agencies.

Any person violating the above, shall be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under section 188 of the IPC and other legal provisions as applicable.

This Orders will come into force with immediate effect.
