ORDER

Whereas, the signatory of this order has been empowered/s-2(1) of Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 read with Clause II of Covid-19 Regulations- 2020 framed by Government of Odisha to take effective measures for containment of the epidemic which has already been declared as a pandemic;

Whereas, the District Disaster Management Authority has the power to take necessary measures U/s 30 to 34 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 to prevent the spread of this disease;

Whereas, the objective of the administration is to go for immediate social distancing, enhanced active surveillance, ensure testing of all suspected cases as per need;

Whereas, **15 (Fifteen) positive cases of COVID-19** has been detected from village-Jhilli under Jhilli GP of Kankadahad Block, Dhenkanal on **24.05.2021**;

Whereas, it is felt necessary to contain any further possible spread of COVID-19 and perspective of public interest and for the sake of speedy completion of active surveillance in the containment zone.

Now therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under Disaster Management Act, 2005 & Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 read with Clause -2 of COVID-19 Regulations- 2020 and in pursuance of order No.2328/ R&DM(DM)/ dt.01.05.2021 of Chief Secretary, Odisha **I Sri Bhumes Chandra Behera, OAS (SAG), Collector & District Magistrate, Dhenkanal do hereby declare the village-Jhilli under Jhilli GP, Kankadahad Block as Micro Containment Zone for 7 days i.e from 7 A.M of 25.05.2021 to 7 A.M of 01.06.2021.**

The restrictions applicable to containment zones as per guidelines of H&FW Department shall be implemented & it will be enforced/ monitored under the direct supervision of the **Sub-Collector & Empowered Officer, Kamakhyanagar**. It is decided not to declare buffer zone adjoining to containment zone. The boundary of **micro containment Zone** as follows.

Boundary point of micro containment Zone

1. Bishnu Charan Behera house=>Jhilli AWC=>Jhilli Nuasahi AWC=>Karan Naik house of the village Jhilli

**Micro Containment measures, as prescribed by MoHFW/H&FW
Department, Government of Odisha.**

- I. (i) Only essential activities shall be allowed.
- (ii) There shall be strict perimeter control to ensure that there is no movement of people in or out of these zones, except for medical emergencies and for maintaining supply of essential goods and services.
- (iii) There shall be intensive house to house surveillance by surveillance teams.
- (iv) Listing of contacts shall be carried out in respect of all persons found positive, along with their tracking, identification, quarantine and follow up of contacts for 14 days (80% of contacts to be traced in 72 hours)
- (v) Surveillance, Tracking and Testing of ILI/SARI cases shall be carried out intensively by medical team.
- II. Quick isolation of COVID-19 patients shall be ensured in treatment facilities/home (subject to fulfilling the home isolation guidelines)
- III. Clinical interventions and clinical Management protocol, as prescribed /required shall be clearly understood and administered.
- IV. Effective Infection, Prevention and Control(IPC) practices shall be followed scrupulously.
- V. Intensive Awareness shall be carried out in communities for strict following of COVID-19 appropriate behaviors and Infection, Prevention and Control (IPC).

All inhabitants of the Containment zones will stay in-door and this is to be followed without deviation. Violation will invite strict penal action as per Disaster Management Act-2005 and Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 & COVID-19 Regulations- 2020. The following officers will act as Nodal Officers to ensure smooth supply of essentials, sanitization, active survey & surveillance, law and order & others in the micro containment Zone.

1. Supply Inspector, Kankadahada Block- Supply of Essential Commodities.
2. Station Fire Officer, Kankadahad Block - Maintenance of sanitation and disinfection.
3. Tahasildar-Cum-Incident Commander, Kankadahad - Maintenance of Law & Order, enforcement and implementation of all activities relating to Containment as per norms.
4. Block Development Officer, Kankadahad-Over all co-ordination
5. CDM&PHO, Dhenkanal/ Medical Officer I/C, Kankadahad-Active house to house surveillance, Tracing, Testing and Treatment and Public Health/ Medical arrangements as situation warranted.
6. Sub-Divisional Police Officer, Kamakhyanagar/IIC, Kankadahad PS, shall make necessary arrangement for immediate deployment of adequate police at the points of requirement and to be supervised accordingly.
7. Overall Supervision & Monitoring- Sub-Collector, Kamakhyanagar.

Testing, Tracking and Treatment


- I. Testing shall be carried out as per prescribed protocol. The proportion of RT-PCR tests in the total mix should be scaled up to the extent possible.
- II. Effective demarcation of micro containment zones, in vulnerable and high incidence areas, is key to breaking the chain of transmission and hence critical to containing the spread of the virus. Therefore, Block Development Officer/Tahasildar-cum-Incident Commander shall carefully demarcate containment zones as per the Guidelines of MoHFW/H&FW Department, Government of Odisha.

Surveillance

The area of Micro Containment zones will be under active surveillance. The **CDM&PHO, Dhenkanal/Medical Officer I/C, Kankadahad**, will mobilize required health staff immediately to conduct surveillance in Containment zones. Supervisory Officers will be also named by the CDM&PHO, Dhenkanal. The active surveillance shall be enforced at least 7 days, however 80% of contacts tracing to be carried out in **7 days i.e. from 25.05.2021 to 01.06.2021**.

The **CDM & PHO, Dhenkanal/Medical Officer I/C, Kankadahad** shall provide required numbers of masks, hand gloves, head covers to all surveillance team members & supervisors for conducting Active Surveillance in Containment zones and train them accordingly. The aforesaid process must be followed as per the guidelines of H&FW, Deptt. Govt. of Odisha & same must be ensured by CDM&PHO, Dhenkanal. All ILI and SARI cases either reported in the last 14 days by the IDSP or ascertained in course of Active Surveillance exercise will be tracked and reviewed thoroughly in Micro Containment zones. Swab will be collected from all cases of suspected/confirmed contact history/Symptoms at the earliest for testing.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect without any dilution and shall remain enforce until **01.06.2021**.


