

Observation Report of Sri Jyoti Shankar Sahoo, Designation Sub-Collector, Kamakhyanagar Supervising Officer on review of MIS of Kankadahad Block of Dhenkanal District.

The MIS Review meeting of Kankadahad Block was held on 11.05.2022 at 8.00 A.M. The BDO/ Tahasildar / Medical Officer / CDPO /AEE /J.E/ GPTS/ MI & other line Department Officers of Soil Conservation/R & B /RD/Agriculture/Forest/Rengali & Right Canal/RWSS Department attended the meeting & the following discussions were made:At the outset, the Sub-Collector welcomed the officers & discussed about the aims of holding such meeting once every month. He impressed upon the members to visit remote & vulnerable areas under this Block & apprise common people about different programme & Scheme of Govt. & to know their problems & take action & address their problems through open discussion.

Proceeding of Mo-Panchayat Mo-Block Review Meeting Kankadahad Panchayat Samiti

Place – Conference hall

Date.11.05.2022, Time – 08.30 AM

Mo Panchayat Mo Block review meeting was held on Dt.11.05.2022 under the Chairmanship of Sri Jyoti Sankar Sahoo OAS-I(S) Sub-Collector Kamakhyanagar. At the outset Sub-Collector wel-come all members present in the meeting and expressed his displeasure over the absentees. He instructed BSSO to prepared a Pre-Printed attendance sheet for taking attendance of members present in meeting.

In his key note address Sub-Collector speaks about the state and role of system in making self-reliant, self sustaining developed nation with retaining a high score of happiness index. Hence each and every individual officer is accountable to provide best service to citizen without any fear and favour. He requested all Nodal Officer and Line Dept Officer to conduct intensive field visit to villages and redress the grievances of villagers at grass root level. As a result of which the villagers may not come to block at the expense of money and time. In this meeting he also instructed all officer to aware villagers about various scheme implemented by different departments. All line dept officer were requested to handover their IEC material like poster, banner, leaflet and manograph of various programme to BDO by 20th May 2022. So that BDO will be able to display them at GP Office Exhibition Hall.

Then he reviewed the performance of Nodal Officer and Line Dept Officer as stated below.

1. **Balikuma**-Nodal Officer Balikuma stated that all PRI member and Line Dept Officer were present in the Mo Panchayat Meeting. In this meeting PRI member raised issue on scarcity of Drinking water. There are 2 tube well found defunt 1 at Urbengi and 1 Kol Up School. They also demanded pipe water supply to all household of GP. In replying to above issue AE RWS&S stated that Mobile team will be visited tomorrow to repair Koi and Urbengi UP School tube wells. He also assured to provide pipe water supply to all villages after commissioning of Mega water supply project. Issue relating to disruption of Mobile communication was discussed in the meeting. Sub collector instructed BDO to intimate the fact to telecom Dept for resolving the issue. In course of discussion PEO request Tahasildar to identify Govt Land for taking up proposed plantation project. Tahasildar Kankadahad has assured to identify land for the said purpose. In intervening the discussion Range Officer has agreed give technical support to GP, to make GP clean and green. In reviewing the sanctioning of old age pension against death vacancy Sub-Collector directed CDPO Kankadahad to submit death report in every month. The BSSO, MI and APO are requested to add new beneficiary against the death vacancy.

2. **Bam-Nodal** Officer Bam Pointed out the issue relating to connectivity to village Pakatamunda as there is no all weather road to this village. In last meeting Sub-Collector has directed PEO to convene Gram Sabha meeting to discussed issue on conversion of forest land and send proposal to Range Officer in Form No.A. As it was not done he expressed his displeasure and again instructed PEO to complete the work within a week. In participating the discussion the range officer stated that the matter has been resolved at DFO level and Forest Dept have given clearance to RD Dept for execution road work. In this regard Sub-Collector asked him to submit the status report on conversion of forest land.
3. **Batagaon-Nodal** Officer has reported about the damaged condition of Batagaon AWC building. In this regard CDPO was directed to visit the spot and instructed Anganwadi Worker to repair building out of fund available with her CDPO also instructed to ensure Nutri Garden in every AWC under her jurisdiction by utilizing MGNREGA fund. Similarly ABEO was advised to implement Nutri Garden programme in all school.
4. **Biribolei-Nodal** Officer stated that all line dept officer were attended Mo Panchayat Meeting at Biribolei. The issue of Child marriage is a major problem of the community. In this regard CDPO was instructed to sensitized parents about the bad repercussion of child marriage.
5. **Birasal**-while discussing various issue relating to development of Birasal GP Nodal Officer has brought to notice of chair about the incompleteness of Rahani AWC building. In participating discussion JE Birasal stated that the project was started in the year 2013-14 with estimated cost rupees 5 lakh, allocated from BRGF. A sum of rupees 2.5 lakh has been paid to executants in running bills. Due to missing of case record further payment of bill to executants was not made. In this regard head clerk and cashier are directed to verify the amount of payment from cash book and retrieve a duplicate case record. JE Birasal was instructed to take measurement of the work and prepare work done bill for rest payment and initiate steps for completion of work. Nodal officer also pointed out that there is no provision of electric power in village Panasia, electrical supervisor was requested to take step for supply of electric power.
6. **Chandpur-Nodal** Officer Chandpur pointed out that there is no toilet water and electricity at Chandpur AWC. In this regard CDPO was instructed to deposit a sum of rupees 4500/- before TPCODL for getting electrical connection. PEO Chandpur was instructed to construct toilet out of CFC fund after taking due approval.
7. **Dashipur-Nodal** Officer Dashipur has pointed out that AWC at Gurujanguli and Kusumundia are in dilapidated condition. CDPO was directed to visit AWC center and take action for repairing these AWC. Similarly the Kusumundia UP School is found unsafe for study. In this regard PEO Dashipur was directed to keep this project in GPDP and execute work on priority basis. Regarding avenue plantation Range Officer was requested to take up Mahabirod to Pangatira road side plantation work through Forest Department.

8. **Garhpalasuni**-Nodal Officer Garhpalasuni has pointed out that there are 2 teacher for imparting lesson to 7 no of Classes at Badasahi UP School. In this regard ABEO was instructed to short out problem by following principle of rationalization in posting. PEO Garhpalasuni was directed to construct kitchen room at Dehurihata Pry School after taking necessary approval.
9. **Ghagaramunda**-while discussing the various issue on Ghagaramunda GP the Nodal Officer pointed out that AWC helper is on long leave without submitting leave application. In this regard CDPO was instructed to conduct inquiry if she was intentionally not attending center then call for explanation.
10. **Jhilli**-Nodal Officer pointed out that the drinking water problem is prevailing in village Toradanali. In this regard AE RWSS was requested to provide water through tanker.
11. **Kankadahad**-In intimating the problem of Kankadahad GP the Nodal Officer stated that out of 5 teacher only 3 teacher are attending Patabeda School similarly students are not coming to suniamaru Pry School. In this regard ABEO was directed to conduct random visit and take action against CRCC and teacher. Nodal Officer also pointed out that the land dispute arises between the villager Patabeda and Rupabeda over a Kaju field issue. Sub-Collector instructed Tahasildar to demarcate the boundary and resolve the dispute between the villagers.
12. **Kantapal**-In discussing problem relating to various issue on Kantapal GP PEO stated that the Ayush doctor is not attending dispensary regularly. As a result of which patients are moving to SDH Kamakhyanagar for their medical treatment in this pandemic situation. Such type of attitude is never expected from a doctor. In discussing above matter BDO Kankadahad also reported that Ayush Doctor posted at Raibol Kantol Pangatira karagola are also not-attending hospital. Sub-Collector instructed BDO to intimate matter to his inspecting Officer posted at District level.
13. **Karagola**-In participating the discussion with Sub-Collector Nodal Officer pointed out for posting of a ANM at Karagola sub-center. He also disclosed that only 3 beneficiary are benefited under Asirbad Yojana out of 10. CDPO is requested to look into this matter.
14. **Kuturia**-PEO has identified a drop out Girl student in village Kuturia Sub-Collector instructed her to take step for her readmission to near by school.
15. **Kantol**-One AWC building is found unsafe so PEO, JE and CDPO are requested to take step for repairing.
16. **Mahabirod**-Nodal Officer reported that Dhobalipathar UP School is in damage condition. PEO is directed to take step for its repairing. In intimating Sub-Collector CDPO said that due to land dispute Mahabirod AWC building is not yet handed over to concerned Anganwadi Worker. In replying the subject AE Kankadahad told that the land dispute is now resolved. As the building stand on Govt. land so it will be transfer to CDPO within few days.
17. **Makuakateni**-Nodal Officer raised issue relating to scarcity of pipe water supply at Jhanjiriberena belaguntha sahi AE admitted the existing problem and it will be solved after completion of Mega Water Supply Project.
18. **Maruabili**-Nodal Officer brought to notice of the chair that the AWC building work at Kharkhari is not completed. JE and CDPO are instructed to

complete the work immediately hand over building Anganwadi Woker, PEO Maruabili raised a complain on delaying in issue of death certificate to family member of deceased person. Mo CHC Birasal was requested to intervene in this subject and dispose all pending cases.

19. **Pangatira**-The post of ANM is vacant at Pangatira Sub-Center as she was on long leave so Mo CHC Birasal is requested to deploy female health worker against the leave vacancy.

20. **Raibol**-The post of Live Stock Inspector was vacant since long days. BVO is requested to intimate fact to CDVO for posting of L.I. Two nos Class room at Mahidharpur Pry School are found in damaged condition PEO, JE and ABEO are instructed conduct field visit and take necessary action for repairing the class room. PEO Railobl have requested superviser TPCODL to shift electric power line standing over Raibol High School to avert electrical accident. The provision of drinking water facility at Sitalbasa, Mahantasahi and Karadapal were also discuss in meeting AE RWSS was instructed to take care of it.

The meeting concluded with vote of thanks to chair .
