"Mo Block Mo Dhenkanal " review meeting of Block was held on 17/06/2022 in the Block Conference Hall, Gondia . BDO / Tahasildar / BEO / BVO / BAO / AAO / AHO / Medical Officer / CDPO / AE / J.Es / MI / WEO / BSSO/AFO/RANGER & other line Department Officers attended the meeting & the following discussions were made.

At the outset Spl. L.A.O, RRCS, Dhenkanal welcomed the officers & discussed about the objectives of the meeting.
