

In the scheme Pisciculture in G.p tanks through long term leasing by WSHGs, 6 no.s WSHGs have taken 1 year lease of 8 no.s G.P tanks in different Gramapanchayat. Documentation of Long term leasing is under progress for these tagged WSHGs. In Biofloc Scheme 24 tanks proposals has been sent for DLSC against 24 tanks target to Block. More 16 no.s proposals has received for further procedure. In the Scheme PMMSY 3 no.s Moped with Ice box and 4 No.s Auto rikshaw with Icebox proposals has been sent to DFO Office, DKL. 2 nos. of proposals under buying Net components also sent to DFO Office, DKL for further action under popularization of Fisheries machinaries & equipments.

Each one in the meeting has aware about using GO SUGAM portal to apply above all the schemes in detail with its log in procedure, documentation, further work order issue to lastly subsidy generation.


