SEALED TENDER NOTICE

Sealed tender in plain papers are invited for disposal of a condemned Govt. Vehicle (Jeep) bearing No-OR -05-S-2539.

The intending tenders may inspect the vehicle at the office premises of the District Fisheries Office, Kunjakanta Dhenkanal on working day between 11.00AM to 2.00PM .The tenders papers should accompany in shape of bank draft towards earnest money deposit of Rs-1000/- (Rupees one Thousand) only in favour of district Fisheries officer Dhenkanal payable at SBI Main Branch Dhenkanal. The earnest money so deposited will be refunded to the unsuccessful tenders.

The last date for submission of tender is Dt- 14.10.2022 (Thursday) up to 2.00PM. Sealed tender paper will be received by registered post/speed post and also can be received in sealed tender box placed in the office chamber of the District Fisheries Office Dhenkanal situated at Kunjakanta, Dhenkanal pin-759001 so as to reach before the schedule date and time .Tender papers received after due date and time shall not be taken into consideration .The tender papers shall be opened in the office Chamber at 3.00PM on date.14.10.2022 in the presence of the tenders or their authorized representatives .

The highest tendered whose tender shall be accepted shall have to deposit 25% of his/her offered amount at the spot on the day of opening of tender ,thereafter only the auction sale will be confirmed the balance amount will have to be deposit within 7 days from the date of confirmation there after he/she shall receive the vehicle from the premises of the District Fisheries Office Dhenkanal with in next 7 days from the date of deposit of the full amount .In case he/she fails to deposit the full amount within the stipulated time, 25% of auction amount so deposited shall be forfeited with earnest money .In other cases the earnest money will be refunded to unsuccessful tendered after completion of tender process.

In case, the succfull tender fails to take the vehicle from the premises of the District Fisheries Office Dhenkanal within the stipulated period ground rent @1% of the tendered amount to be charged for each day or [Part thereof. If the Ground rent so charged, exceeds the auction amount deposited the tender shall cease to have any right over the vehicle and the amount deposited by tender shall be adjusted towards ground rent.

The authority reserves the right to reject the highest tender or other tender without assigning any reasons thereof, at any point of time.
