The ST & SC Development Department is the nodal Department for overall policy, planning and coordination of programmes for development of the Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Caste, Minorities & other Backward Classes in the State with the objective of providing socio economic development as well as overall development of the most under-privileged sections of the society namely ST & SC Development, M & BCW Department.

- 3 Infrastructural Development
- 4 Skill Development
- 5 Preservation and promotion of art, culture and traditions.
- 6 Promotion and Development of voluntary efforts on tribal welfare
- 7 protection from Social Exploitation and safeguarding the constitutional & traditional rights.
- 8 Ensure the Rights of Forest Dwelling Scheduled Tribes on forest lands.

1	Boarding House Stipend (Class - I to X)	Stipend provided to ST&SC students in residential hostels
2	Saheed Madhosingh Haath Kharcha Yojana (For class IX & XI)	Onetime incentive @ Rs.5000/- provided to the ST students of class IX & XI to reduce the drop out rate.
3	Pre Matric Scholarship (State Share : Class VI to X )	Stipend provided to ST&SC students
4	Pre Matric Scholarship for OBC/ SEBC & EBC students of class IX & X (Govt. schools only)	Stipend provided to OBC, SEBC & EBC students
5	Post Matric Scholarship for ST&SC students	Stipend provided to ST&SC students
6	Post Matric Scholarship for OBC/ SEBC & EBC	Stipend provided to OBC, SEBC & EBC students
7	Writing Material (for class IX & X students)	An amount of Rs.300/- per annum student is provided to the ST&SC students
8	Supply of free Text Book to class IX & X students	An amount of Rs.300/- per annum is provided to the ST&SC students for purchase of writing material
9	Supply of free text books (Class IX & X)	Free text books supplied to the ST&SC students.
10	Supply of free uniform (Class IX & X)	Free uniforms provided to ST&SC students
11	Inter Hostels Sports competiton.	Financial assistance is being provided to the schools for organisation of annual sports at school level and District level in order to provide them wider expouser in various sports activities.

12	Art & Culture	Financial assistance is being provided to the schools to promote and preserve traditional culture of the tribals, folk songs, dance & painting for observation of cultural programme (SARGIFULA) at School Level and District Level
13	Setting of ICT lab.	Financial assistance is being provided to all High Schools to setup Informaiton, Communication & Technology lab to educate the Tribal students.
14	Science Exhibition	Financial assistance is being provided to all High Schools to exhibit science exhibition at school level and district level for ST&SC students.
15	Parents as Parter meeting	Financial assistance is being provided to all Schools to organies Parent as Parter Meeting (PTM) to envolve and aware the parents in various schools and hostels activities.
16	Life Skill Education programme	Life Skill Education programme is being implemented in all schools to provide life skill education to SC&ST students.
17	Skill Development & enterpreneurship Development	Training is imparted to unemployed SCST youths in different trades like -1.Mushroom cultivation, AC & refrigerator repairing, Mobile Repairing, Tailoring, Poultry farming, beauty & wellness, Asst. Maching Operator, Solar PV installation etc. and placement is being provided to unemployeed ST&SC youths.
18	Construction of Residential Schools and Hostels	Quality educaiton is provided to SCST students through Tribal residential schools
19	Construction Girls Hostel	Hostel for STSC girls are constructed by ST&SC Dev. Deptt. and handed over to School & Mass Education Deptt. for functioning of the hostel.
20	Setting of Ekalabya Model School	With the aim to provide quality and value based Education among the ST children, hailing from poor tribal families. The EMR Schools are constructued under the administrative control of Tribal Welfare Deptt. One EMRS School is under construction in Dhenkanal District.
21	Pradhan Mantri Aadarsha Gram Yojana (PMAGY)	52 nos. of villages having (more than 50% SC Population) has been selected under Pradhan Mantri Aadarsh Gram Yojana to improve the Socio Economic status of the SC people.
22	Income Generating Acticities	Financial support provided to poor SC SHG for Income Generation through Plantation, Goatery, Diary Farming, Poultry, Chhatua Processing, Mushroom Cultivation etc.
23	Pradhan Mantri Adi Aadarsha Gram Yojana (PMAAY)	24 nos of villages having (more than 50% ST Population) has been selected under PMAAY. Gram Sabha has been conducted & proposal submitted to Govt. for Placement of Funds.

24	Implementation of Forest Right Act, 2006.	Rights on forest land are vested to the eligible applicants as per the Forest Right Act, 2006. Benefits are also extended to the recipients of the Forest rights under "Economic Benefit Scheme" through line departments & MGNREGA. Besides PMAY housing also given to the forest right title holders through convergence mode.
25	Implementation of Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989	Compensation benefit is provided to the victim person as committed liability of the State Government under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities ) Act, 1989
26	Inter Caste Marriage incentive	Incentives is being provided to the couples having one spouse belonging in to general caste & other of SC caste of Hindu Community to iradicate the untouchability system protection from Social Exploitation and safeguarding the constitutional & traditional rights and to include them in mainstream of the society.
27	Aid to Non Government Organisation (NGO)	Financial Assistance is being provided to the dedicated registered Aid to volunary organization Recurring Non-Recurring grants (NGOs) working in the field of capiacity building, education, Residential School health & sanitation, for overall improvement of the scheduled tribes & scheduled caste.
28	PM JANMAN	Juang Development Agency is functioning at Kamakhyanagar for overall Development of the PVTG poeople . In Dhenkanal District 10931 "Juang' Population are residing in 112 nos. of villages and covered unde PM-JANMAN Scheme. In Dhenkanal District "Juang" is the only PVTG Community.
